**UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS**

**BACHELOR OF ARCHITECTURE,  
FIRST PROFESSIONAL DEGREE (B.ARCH)**

This degree puts you on the path to be a licensed architect. In addition to hands-on learning in Design Studio, this NAAB-accredited B.Arch degree covers the history and theory of architecture, materials and structures, as well as all the requisite technical skills.

**BACHELOR OF ARTS IN ARCHITECTURE**

You love architecture, but you don't want to be a licensed architect. That makes you the ideal candidate for the BAA, which provides entrée to a broad range of careers in architecture and design. **BACHELOR OF LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE**

This program emphasizes the design and advocacy for public spaces, creating awareness of the ecology of the city and exploring the relationships between urban core and the larger landscape that supports it.

**BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN

**GRADUATE PROGRAMS**

**MASTER OF ARCHITECTURE,  
FIRST PROFESSIONAL DEGREE (M.ARCH I)**

Undergraduate degree-holders in any field are eligible to pursue the M.Arch I, the First Professional Degree that is vital for licensure as an architect. The M.Arch I degree at NSAD is fully accredited by the National Architecture Accrediting Board (NAAB). There are two options for those pursuing the M.Arch I:

**Three-Year Program**

If your bachelor's degree is in a field other than architecture, you will enroll in this three-year, comprehensive program that includes both foundational and advanced studies of architecture and design.

**Two-Year Program**

If you hold a bachelor's degree in architecture or a related field such as environmental design, you are eligible for the two-year program. You'll apply your foundational knowledge in architecture and design to more advanced architectural study and studio work.

**MASTER OF ARCHITECTURE (M.ARCH II)**

If you plan to teach architecture or want a deeper understanding of the principles of architecture and design, you will find the M.Arch II most suitable for you. Designed for licensed, practicing architects who have already obtained a First Professional Degree from a five-year B.Arch program, and are ready to advance their knowledge and skills for advancement in the field.

**MASTER OF CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT**

Emphasis in this program is placed on sustainable design, integrated project delivery and practice-oriented learning. This program is offered entirely online and, depending on individual progress, including number of courses taken per quarter, can be completed in as little as one year.

**MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ARCHITECTURE**

If you're a professional in an associated field such as real estate development, city planning, or urbanism and want to advance your chosen career rather than

pursue architectural licensure, this one-year program can help you develop a practical understanding of architecture and design.

**MASTER OF LANDSCAPE  
ARCHITECTURE (MLA)**

This multi-disciplinary program integrates a deep exploration of the theories and practices of landscape architecture and design with high-impact studio work. **EXECUTIVE MASTERS PROGRAM**

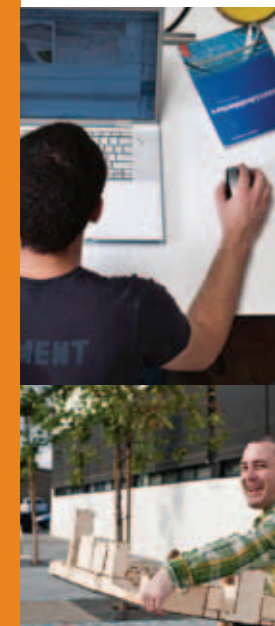

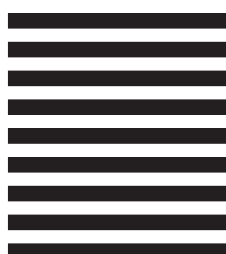

**INSTITUTIONAL ACCREDITATION**

NewSchool of Architecture and Design is accredited by the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools (ACICS) to award associate degrees, bachelor's degrees, and master's degrees.

**PROGRAMMATIC ACCREDITATION**

In the United States, most state registration boards require a degree from an accredited professional degree program as a prerequisite for licensure. The National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB), which is the sole agency authorized to accredit U.S. professional degree programs in architecture, recognizes three types of degrees: the Bachelor of Architecture, the Master of Architecture, and the Doctor of Architecture. A program may be granted a 6-year, 3-year, or 2-year term of accreditation, depending on the extent of its conformance with established educational standards.

Doctor of Architecture and Master of Architecture degree programs may consist of a pre-professional undergraduate degree and a professional graduate degree that, when earned sequentially, constitute an accredited professional education. However, the pre-professional degree is not, by itself, recognized as an accredited degree.

NewSchool of Architecture and Design offers the following NAAB-accredited degree programs:

- B. Arch. (235 quarter undergraduate credits)
- M. Arch. (pre-professional degree + 90 quarter graduate credits)
- M. Arch. (non-pre-professional degree + 135 quarter credits)
- M. Arch. (license + pre-professional degree + 45 quarter credits)
