#### ARCHITECTURE EXPLORATION

##### See and Do

Students early in their architecture studies learn from experts through two weeks of tours and hands-on experience. Experienced architects guide students through architectural wonders in San Diego and Los Angeles. After visiting both architectural sites and firms, students discuss contemporary topics facing the profession. Students apply aspects of what they see and learn in computer labs, guided drawing sessions, and design studios, all facilitated by experienced faculty. By preparing and presenting a portfolio of their work, students deepen their understanding of contemporary architecture as they develop practical skills.
