## SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT 2009-2010 ACADEMIC YEAR

### TO ALL NSAD STUDENTS:

NewSchool of Architecture & Design annually awards Presidential scholarships to students in both the B.Arch and M.Arch programs. All eligible students are encouraged to apply by the deadline noted below. Scholarship awards are made for varying amounts, generally from \$1,000 to \$10,000 per year, with specific amounts dependent on the number of recommended applicants and the amount of funds available.

Scholarship funds are disbursed quarterly during the academic year. Awards become effective in the Fall term. Awards may be pro-rated for students taking less than a full load of coursework.

Scholarship and leadership are the two most important criteria used in determining recipients. In addition, applicants will be reviewed for the significance of their work as recognized by the faculty and/or other professionals, and service that leads to the betterment of NewSchool. A minimum cumulative grade average of 3.25 is required. Continuing student applicants must confirm that they have activated their [newschoolarch.edu](http://newschoolarch.edu) email address as part of the process.

Scholarship applications from continuing students must be submitted no later than **4:00pm, Friday, May 22, 2009**. The applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, chaired by Dean Gilbert Cooke. The Committee will make its recommendations to the President, and final awards will be made no later than June 12, 2009.

There are two application cycles for new students. The first application cycle has a deadline of **May 15, 2009**. Awards are typically announced by June 12, 2009. The second application deadline for new students is **June 30, 2009** and awards are typically announced by July 31, 2009. The applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and the Committee will make its recommendations to the President.

Please complete the following application and submit it with the requested materials to Academic Services Coordinator's office, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Main Building prior to the deadline. Failure to comply with the application requirements, or late filings, will be disqualified from consideration. Please direct your questions to Dean Cooke in the interim.

For continuing students, contents must include NewSchool Design Studio project examples, including work and process samples and one written sample. In addition, artwork, professional projects, or essays may be included.
  - Students who have submitted portfolios in previous years may retrieve them from the Dean’s office for updating if they so choose.
  - New and Continuing students not yet enrolled in the studio sequence may elect other examples of their work to the extent this is available.
